Notably, this extraordinary transaction was arranged by two Dujat member companies - Mizuho Securities (Tokyo, London) with the support of CDI Global (Japan).

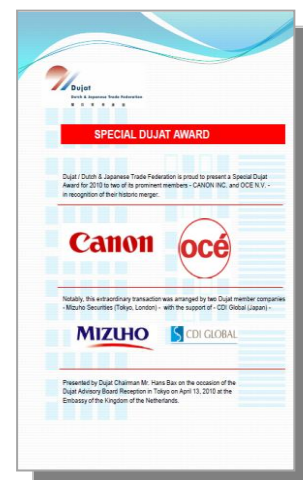
